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1 The Square and the Old Town Hall Tower



The square surrounded by burgher houses with Renaissance and Baroque facades is the natural centre of the whole **urban conservation area**. The most valuable house in the square is the house called „**At the White Horse**“ (U Bílého koníčka) from 1544. Other points of interest include buildings such as the **Štěpánek Netolický House** and **The Old Town Hall**. Its 31m high **tower** offers a magnificent view of the surrounding countryside. In the middle of the square stands a Renaissance **stone fountain** and a Baroque **Marian Column**. The entrance to the town is guarded by several massive **gates**.

Only a few Czech towns can boast with such an old and **rich theatre tradition** as the town of Třeboň. From the mid-16th century plays with biblical themes were performed in the local **monastery**. During the period of the last Rosenbergs plays were also performed **at the castle**. Some itinerant theatre companies as well as amateur brewing burghers and castle officers performed here in the 18th century. **Josef Kajetán Tyl**, a famous Czech playwright, gave guest performances in Třeboň twice – in 1852 and 1856. The theatre that now bears his name was built in **1833**. An artistically **precious curtain** with an allegorical scene of the arrival of Apollo with his company to the town, by the painter František Skála from Písek, is a part of the decoration in the theatre.

3 The Church of Our Lady and St. Giles and the Augustinian Monastery



The decanal church is mentioned as a parish church as early as 1280. After the founding of the Augustinian monastery in 1367, the church was rebuilt in **the Gothic style**. At that time, presumably the most important painter of Gothic panels in Bohemia, **the Master of the Třeboň altar**, left his unique work here. Surviving panels of the Třeboň altar are currently part of the collections of the National Gallery in Prague. The Gothic church with a double-naved layout still retains a world-famous Gothic sculpture, **Madonna of Třeboň**, from around 1400. **The cloister**, adjoining the northern part of the church, has survived with almost intact **frescoes** and a cloister garden with a well.

Originally there was a manor house, situated at the site of the present castle complex. It was gradually rebuilt into a fort and later into a little stone castle. In 1366, **the house of Rosenbergs** became the owner of the Třeboň dominion.

In 1602, **Petr Vok of Rosenberg** chose Třeboň for his residency. After his death in 1611, the castle was inherited by **the Švamberks** and in 1660 it passed over to the powerful **Schwarzenberg house**.

In 1958, Třeboň castle, one of the largest castle complexes in the Czech Republic, was declared a national cultural monument. These days the castle offers its visitors **guided tours and historical exhibits**. **The House of Nature** of the Třeboň area is also on the castle premises.

5 Bohemia Regent Brewery

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The earliest written reference to brewing in Třeboň is from 1379. The brewery acquired its present appearance during the second half of the 19th century. The brand name of the Regent brewery is inspired by the historical figure of **Jakub Krčín of Jelčany and Sedlčany** (1535-1604), who was a regent of the vast dominion of Vilém of Rosenberg. The brewery offers its visitors **tours of the historic building** in connection with **tasting** the "golden nectar".

6 The Schwarzenberg Tomb



The Tomb of the House of Schwarzenberg is **one of the most architecturally remarkable sights** to be visited in South Bohemia. The construction, including the building of a complex drainage system for the tomb, placed below ground level, lasted from 1874 to 1877. **The Neo-Gothic two-storey tomb** is in the shape of a regular hexagon. In the tomb there are **26 coffins** and a precious **marble sarcophagus**.

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7 The House of Nature of the Třeboň region



The visitor centre of the Třeboň Protected Landscape Area (PLA) situated in the castle provides information about the countryside, educational paths and points of interest in the area. The permanent exhibition “**Landscape and People**” offers visitors a unique look into the history and development of the Třeboň landscape, entertaining and educating activities **for the whole family** and thematic films.

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The first fishponds were established in the Třeboň area in the second half of the 14th century. Dvořiště and Bošilec ponds are reported to be the oldest. The golden era of fish farming came in the 16th century, along with the names Štěpánek Netolický, Jakub Krčín of Jelčany and Sedlčany and Mikuláš Rutard of Malešov. More than 500 large and small ponds form 16 systems in the Třeboň area, the best known of which being the Naděje and Chlumec systems.

An extremely valuable mosaic of ponds, forests, wet meadows, peat bogs and human settlements has been preserved here despite long-term cultivation of the landscape by man, thanks to ingenious landscaping and water management. The territory was included among the UNESCO biosphere reserves in 1977. The most valuable parts of the Třeboňsko region are protected in 32 nature reserves and landmarks. 16 Sites of European Community Interest (SCI-SAC) have been designated in the Třeboňsko PLA.

8 Štěpánek Netolický House The Třeboň Fish Pond Building Heritage Centre



Štěpánek Netolický House can be found in the historic centre of town, in the Masaryk Square. There is a **visitor centre** and a permanent **interactive educational exhibition** dedicated to the Třeboň Fish Pond Building Heritage and the personality of the fish pond builder and architect Štěpánek Netolický. Besides the permanent exhibition, Štěpánek Netolický House also offers **gallery spaces** suitable for short-term exhibitions, lectures, workshops and other **cultural events**.



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9 The Buddhist Art Gallery in the Water Tower



An author's replica of Kotěra's water tower at Zelená liška in Prague was built in Třeboň in **1909**. Water was originally pumped to the tower from a 10m deep well by a petrol pump. After the 2nd World War the tower was **decommissioned**. At present it is a Buddhist art gallery.

The building is accessible to previously booked groups.

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It is situated on the first floor of the Old Town Hall in Masaryk Square. It offers its visitors a permanent exhibition „**The Story of the Town Třeboň in Eight Centuries**“ telling the history of the town and its inhabitants, church buildings and schools. The museum is administered by the Club of Třeboň Friends, which also organises **short-term thematic exhibitions** and **lectures** in the winter period.
